MINUTES OF FIFTH ANNUAL MEETING HELD SEPTEMBER 18, 1933.

The fifth annual meeting of the Football Officials' Association of Central Pennsylvania was held at the Harrisburger Hotel at Harrisburg on September 18, 1933. President Taggart presided. 44 members present.

Minutes of the business meeting of December 5, 1932 were read and approved.

Treasurer's report showing receipts of \$366.68 and expenditures of \$166.69, leaving a balance of \$199.99, was read and accepted.

Auditing committee consisting of Messrs. Reagan, White and Geisel were appointed to audit the Treasurer's accounts. Committee reported as having found Treasurer's report correct.

Report of Committee. President Taggart and V. Pres. Miller, delegate and alternate, respectively, reported upon the meeting of football officials with officials of the P.I.A.A. The questions of (1) police protection for officials, (2) fees, (3) contracts for officials, and (4) standards for membership in football officials' association were discussed and it was decided that a committee of football officials be appointed to meet with the P.I.A.A. to come to decision on the above matters.

Election of Officers. - Nominations for officers of the Association for the year 1933 was had. Nominations for Pres. Taggart, V. Pres. E. Miller, Secretary-Treasurer Scheffer, Directors Dayhoff and Grube. It was moved and seconded that Secretary cast ballot for each position, except Secretary-Treasurer, that to be cast by Miller, V. President. Motion passed.

New Business. - The question of retaining the Rating Card system was discussed. It was moved and seconded that the system be retained. Motion passed. Pres. Taggart requests all members to make out cards.

Mr. Thomas makes and Mr. Reagan seconds, a motion that if any information on the Rating Card of an official that may be beneficial to that member be sent to him at end of season provided that at least 5 cards are turned in. Motion passed.

Application of Mr. Fred Burns of York for transfer of his membership from the N.Y. State Asso. of Cert. Football Officials to this Association was presented and read and upon a motion made by Schwenk and seconded by Bush, to the effect that Mr. Burns be approved for membership upon condition that the N.Y. State Association extend to members of our Association reciprocal

privileges, in compliance with our By-Laws. Motion carried.

Application of Spurgeon Gingrich of York was presented and read. After remarks upon applicant by recommendor it was moved and seconded that applicant be approved. Motion carried.

Motion for adjournment was made at 9:35. Motion passed.

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING DECEMBER 12, 1933

A business meeting of the Association was held on Monday evening December 12, 1933 at the Harrisburger Hotel after the Annual Dinner. President Taggart presided. 48 members were present. Minutes of the annual business meeting held on September 18, 1933 were read and approved.

New Business. Resignations were read from John B. Kennedy of Columbia and Leon A. Campozano. Mr. Kennedy advises that he has discontinued football officiating. Mr. Campozano, formerly of Camp Hill, advises that he has moved to West Chester and has affiliated with the Philadelphia Board. Resignations accepted.

The names of two members of the Association were read who had become in arrears with their dues. A motion was made that the two members, James A. Ford of Burnham and C. D. MacGregor of Carlisle be expelled. Motion passed.

Moved by J. Francella, seconded by R. Greene, after some discussion, that this Association go on record to recommend to the Harrisburg School Board and the Chamber of Commerce, or any other interested organization, the project of a municipal stadium for Harrisburg. Also a committee to be appointed from this organization to take this matter up with the designated bodies. The Committee appointed by President Taggart consisted of H. Geisel, Chr., C. R. Beck and R. Houtz.

Moved and seconded that meetings of this group be held at the Penn Harris Hotel in 1934. Motion defeated.

Moved and seconded that the matter of meeting place for 1934 be referred to the Executive Committee. Motion passed.

Moved and seconded for adjournment-11:30.
