MINUTES OF SIXTH ANNUAL MEETING HELD SEPTEMBER 17, 1934.

The sixth annual meeting of the Football Officials Association of Central Pennsylvania was held at the Harrisburger Hotel at Harrisburg on September 17, 1934. President Taggart presided. 46 members present.

Minutes of the business meeting held December 12, 1933 were read and approved.

Treasurer's report showing receipts of \$407.99 and expenditures of \$208.85, leaving a balance of \$199.14, was read and approved.

Auditing Committee consisting of Messrs. Dayhoff, Francella and Morrett were appointed to audit the Treasurer's accounts. Committee reported as having found Treasurer's report correct.

Reports of Committee. - H. G. Geisel, Chairman of the Committee appointed at the last meeting for the purpose of taking up the matter of a Municipal Stadium with the Harrisburg School Board and the Harrisburg Chamber of Commerce, reported that this had been done without obtaining any action from those bodies.

Election of Officers. - Nominations for officers of this Association for the year 1934 were made. The following men were nominated: for President, E. C. Taggart, for V. Pres., E. E. Miller, for Secretary-Treasurer, L. K. Scheffer, for Executive Board, H. O. Dayhoff and R. Y. Grube. It was moved and seconded that Secretary cast ballot for each position, except that of Secretary-Treasurer, and that to be cast by E. E. Miller, Vice-President. Motion passed.

After President Taggart had spoken relative to the advantages of Associations, similar to our Association meeting at various places, H. O. Dayhoff moved, W. Doremus seconded, that the Secretary be instructed to write the Lancaster Group and the Carlisle Group advising them that, if invited, we would be glad for the opportunity to meet with them at least once during the present football season. Motion passed.

Moved by E. E. Miller, seconded by W. T. Euker that that Rating Cards which this Association had been using for a number of years, be not used this season. Motion passed.

The application for membership to this Association of Stanley Earl Walker was presented and read. It was moved and

seconded that he be admitted. Motion passed.

Moved and seconded that meeting adjourn.

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING, DECEMBER 17, 1934.

The Annual Dinner of the Association was held on Monday evening December 17, 1934 at the Harrisburger Hotel in Harrisburg. After the dinner and the Social Hour, a business meeting was held. Vice President Miller presided. 53 members were present.

Minutes of the Annual Business meeting held on September 17, 1934 were read and approved.

After some discussion, ~~at~~ Committee, consisting of A. Wilsbach, Chairman, H. Geisel, and E. Hiller, was appointed to draw up an amendment to the By-Laws of this Association regulating requirements for membership.

It was moved and seconded that a vote of thanks be extended by the Association to the Entertainment Committee. Motion passed.

It was moved and seconded that a letter of thanks be sent to the Management of the Harrisburger Hotel for their courtesy extended during the past season. **MOTION PASSED.**

The names of two members of the Association were read, who had become in arrears with their dues. It was moved and seconded that Captain F. A. Greer and Glen Moffatt be expelled for non-payment of dues. Motion passed.

A card of resignation was read from Roger Greene. It was moved and seconded that his resignation be accepted. Motion passed.
