MINUTES OF THE EIGHTH ANNUAL MEETING, SEPTEMBER 14, 1936.

The Eighth Annual meeting of the Football Officials' Association of Central Pennsylvania was held at the Central Y. M. C. A. at Harrisburg on September 14, 1936. President E. E. Miller presided with 50 members present.

Minutes of the business meeting held on the Evening of the annual banquet, December 2, 1935 were read and approved

Treasurer's report showing receipts of \$426.57 and expenditures of \$264.35 leaving a balance as of September 14, 1935 of \$162.22 was read and approved.

Motion carried.

New Business. After a census of the members was made it was moved and seconded that the date for the Eighth Annual Banquet be set for Monday Evening, November 30, 1936. Motion carried.

Beck that this Association go on record against the use of dry lime for lining of football fields, due to the danger to the players, and that the Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association be so notified, and requesting that body to notify its members of this action. Motion carried.

It was moved by W. E. Nitrauer and seconded by E. Schwenk that the Annual Banquet of this Association be held yearly on the last Monday of November. Motion carried.

After some discussion, it was moved and seconded that the president appoint a committee of six members for the purpose of studying the present By-Laws of this Association and report thereon at the annual meeting in September 1937. Motion carried. The president appointed the following committee, W. E. Nitrauer, Chairman, C. R. Beck, R. H. Rauch, P. L. Reagan, R. W. Schreck and E. Schwenk.
