MINUTES OF MEETING HELD SEPTEMBER 18, 1944

A business meeting of the Football Officials' Association of Central Pennsylvania was held Monday September 18, 1944 at the Y. M. C. A. Harrisburg, Penna. Vice-President Jas. R. Peifer presided with twenty-nine members present.

Minutes of the Annual Business Meeting held November 22, 1943 were read and approved.

Vice-President asked for a Roll Call of Members.

Treasurer's report showing receipts of \$408.47 and expenditures of \$362.31, leaving a balance as of September 18, 1944 of \$46.16 was read and approved by the auditing committee, consisting of Earl W. Killinger, Robert W. Schreck and Carl L. Beck.

Election of Officers: Nominations for officers for the Association for the year 1944 were opened and the following members were nominated: For President, Wayne S. Metka, E. E. Miller and Jas. R. Peifer; for Vice-President, Jas. R. Peifer; Executive Board, Clarence R. Beck, John J. Furjanic, W. E. Nitrauer, Earl W. Killinger and William A. Doremus. The results of the Election, President, E. E. Miller; Vice President, Jas R. Peifer; Executive Board, Clarence R. Beck and William A. Doremus.

A motion was made by William A. Doremus and seconded by Robert Schreck that we accept Roy B. Albrights dues for 1943 and reinstate him in good standing. Motion Carried.

A motion was made by Robert Schreck and seconded by William A. Doremus that E. G. Diffenbach be reinstated into the Association and dues for 1942 and 1943 be suspended. Motion Carried.

A motion was made by Geo. Hohenshelt that we increase our yearly dues of the Association to \$5.00, same increase being made to cover increase of cost of insurance and mid-season luncheon. Motion seconded by Robt. Schreck. Motion Carried.

A motion was made by Harry Nye and seconded by Clarence R. Beck that the Association pay the necessary fee for one underprivileged boy membership for one year to the Y.M.C.A. of Harrisburg. Motion Carried.

It was suggested by Jos. G. Crowley that Robert Hall Craig, deceased be so listed as Honorary Member Deceased.

Vice-President, Jas. R. Peifer appointed Ted Rosenberg and W. R. Nitrauer to present a resolution in reference to the death of Robert Hall Craig.
