MINUTES OF MEETING HELD SEPTEMBER 15, 1947

A business meeting of the Central Penna Chapter P. I. A. A. Football Official's Association was held Monday September 15, 1947 at the Park Dept Office, Harrisburg, Penna. President Jas. R. Peifer presided with 51 members present.

Minutes of the previous business meeting held September 9, 1946 were read and approved.

Roll Call of members was requested by the President.

Treasurer's report showing receipts of \$664.51 and expenditures of \$519.29 for the year, leaving a balance of \$145.22 in the bank as of September 15, 1947 was read by the Treasurer and approved.

The following officers were elected for the year 1947-1948. President Jas. R. Peifer-Vice President Clarence R. Beck. Members of the advisory board elected were William A. Doremus and David R. Dayhoff.

A motion was made by Clarence R. Beck that the Secretary write a letter to Mr. Wicht, Ex. Sec. of the P. I. A. A. requesting permission to increase the membership of our Chapter above the limited membership of sixty members and that we are not in favor of the Board of Controls action of this limitation nor in favor of another chapter in Harrisburg. Also to limit the examinations in such a fashion that it will not be necessary to have another association. Motion seconded and approved.

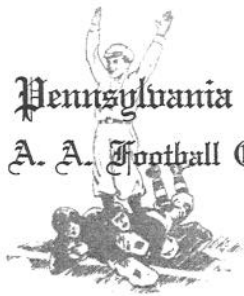
A motion was made and approved that we admit the new members pending approval of permission to increase our chapter membership.
