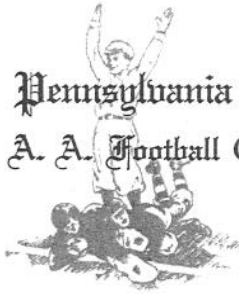
A motion was made by Ray Hartzell that the Chapter have the By-Laws printed and a copy be presented to each member. Motion Defeated.

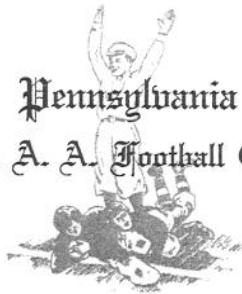
