Minutes of the 27th Annual Meeting, held 14 November 1955
at the Brownstone Building, Reservoir Park,
Harrisburg, Pennsylvania

The meeting was called to order by President Don Enders.

Minutes of the previous meeting, held 15 November 1954, were read and approved.

The Secretary-Treasurer gave an informal report on the financial condition of the chapter.

The Secretary-Treasurer read a letter sent to three members at mid-season in which three members were advised that their attendance was not satisfactory. The following action was taken on the three members in question, the action being taken on the basis of the complete season's attendance record:

John Russ attended no meetings out of a possible 10. Moved by Al Hill That the final report show 10 absences and that his name be dropped from the 1956 Roster. Motion approved.

Gordon Buck Jones had attended two meetings since midseason and had submitted a letter to the Secretary advising that his job would necessitate repeated absences. Moved by Roy Lutz that the excused absences be credited for attendance and that Buck Jones be advised that, in future seasons, only personal attendance at not less than five meetings would be acceptable. Motion carried.

Don Helsley attended three meetings during the season and had submitted a letter to the Secretary in which he said that his job would prevent his regular attendance at Chapter meetings. Moved by Phil Raudensky that action be taken as in the case of Buck Jones. Motion carried.

The Chapter was advised that the resolution of 1954 asking that black caps be made a part of the official uniform was rejected by the District Committee. Lew Clionsky moved that the resolution be resubmitted. Motion carried.

Ed Marion moved that a letter be sent to the South Penn Conference suggesting that, in view of increased cost of travel, uniforms, and equipment, the member schools give serious consideration to an increase in game fees. Following more discussion the motion carried with the proviso that the Secretary secure the interest and cooperation of other officials' chapters in the area.

It was moved by Phil Raudensky that Harry Sherman's name be submitted as this Chapter's nominee for the post of officials' representative. Motion carried.

Ed Marion moved that dues for 1956 be \$10.00. Carried.
