The Board repeats that it can see no reason why all members cannot attend a minimum of five of the eleven, and emphasizes that that attendance will be required of every member.

Incidentally, Ray had the courtesy to advise the Secretary that he was returning schedules in time for the Secretary to fill most of his games.

29th Annual Meeting, Monday, 18 November 1957

MINUTES

Minutes of the meeting of November 12, 1956 were read and approved. A report of the treasury was presented.

The only report from committee was on behalf of the Banquet Committee, Dick Shover, chairman. Members were Fred Bennett, Brandt Cook, Roy Lutz and Severino Stefanon. The same committee handled the frolic, with Brandt Cook acting as chairman.

It was suggested by Lee Moyer that we look for another place to hold weekly meetings, inasmuch as the Brownstone Building had been most difficult to have heated this year. It was the opinion of the meeting that the Executive Board should secure another meeting place. The Harrisburg YMCA was suggested.

Al Hill moved that we dispense with the Frolic and use the funds saved to defray the expenses of having all wives as guests at future banquets. The motion was seconded by Fred Bennett. After lengthy discussion, the motion carried.

Joe Mulligan offered a motion to change the format of the annual roster to make it in booklet form, pocket-size, and to include a calendar to permit entering of scheduled games, fellow officials and pertinent information. Paul Pugh seconded the motion but it failed to carry.

After much pro-and-con regarding the loss to officials stemming from Rained-out games, Ed Marion presented this resolution and moved its approval:
