MINUTES

The 36th Annual Meeting of the Central Pennsylvania Football Chapter, PIAA Football Officials, was called to order by President Paul Marinak at 8:00 P.M. at the Camp Hill High School, with 48 members present.

Minutes of the 35th Annual Meeting were approved as mailed to the membership by Severino Stefanon, Secretary.

Joe Manmiller, treasurer, reported on the current status of the Chapter treasury. Balance \$119.60. See attached.

President Marinak having complied with Article IX - Amendments of the association's constitution, submitted the following proposed changes to existing constitution.

Article V - Officers

Section 1 - The officers of the Chapter shall be a President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and Interpreter.

Moved by Bennett, seconded by Quigley. Motion carried.

Article VII

Section 1 - Regular meetings of the chapter shall be held during the football season, on the dates set by the Board of Directors.

After some discussion on the wording set forth by Marinak the group decided on the above wording.

Moved by Thomas, seconded by Clionsky. Motion carried.

There was some discussion on assignment of ball games. It was abruptly halted when facts were stated.


