MINUTES OF FIRST BUSINESS MEETING OF 1972, SEPT 5

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER BY PRESIDENT KEN SASSAMAN

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING WERE READ BY SECRETARY.

CORRESPONDENCE. LETTER WAS READ THANKING CEDAR CLIFF FOR USE OF BUILDING. REPORT WAS MADE BY SECRETARY THAT WE HAD TO PROVIDE LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR USE OF BUILDING. COST OF INSURANCE \$19.00 PER YEAR. POLICY WAS ISSUED PRIOR TO START OF SEASON BY INA. APPROVED BY EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.

AUDITING COMMITTEE REPORT WAS MADE BY JACK MURRAY.

OLD BUSINESS: NONE

NEW BUSINESS: MOTION BY STAN SMITH SECOND BY DORNISCH THAT NEW APPLICANTS MCNAMARA, HEIGES AND OLITSKY BE ACCEPTED ON PROBATION FOR TWO YEARS. VOTE APPROVED. TRANSFER APPLICATION ON VIC KARYCKI WAS HELD UP PENDING REPORT FROM THE OTHER CHAPTER SECRETARY.

Central Pennsylvania Chapter PIAA Football Officials

TO: Ken Sassaman, President - Central Pa. Chapter PIAA Football Off.
Fred Bennett, Secretary - Central Pa. Chapter PIAA Football Off.

I would like to recommend for consideration by Chapter members the following two (2) amendments:

Change Article 5 - Officers, Section 3

to read: The term of each officer shall be for one year except the Secretary who shall be elected for three years, or until his successor is elected.

Change Article 8 - Attendance

to read: A minimum of six (6) meetings, not including the PIAA Football Interpretation meeting. Also, three (3) meetings and not including the PIAA Football Interpretation meeting is required eligibility prior to official football season.

MINUTES OF FINAL BUSINESS MEETING 1972, NOVEMBER 13

MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY PRESIDENT KEN SASSAMAN.

MINUTES OF THE LAST BUSINESS MEETING WERE READ BY SECRETARY FRED BENNETT.

TREASURERS REPORT. BOB GALLAGHER REPORTED A BALANCE IN THE BANK OF \$2,287.94

OLD BUSINESS: UNDER OLD BUSINESS AN AMENDMENT WAS PRESENTED BY CHARLES JOHNS TO CHANGE ARTICLE #5 & Article #8 MR JOHNS WITHDREW HIS REQUEST TO CHANGE ARTICLE #5 OF HIS LETTER DATED OCT 30, 1972. A VOTE WAS TAKEN ON THE CHANGE OF ARTICLE #8 ATTENDANCE. TO READ: " A MINIMUM OF (6) MEETINGS, NOT INCLUDING THE PIAA INTERPRETATION MEETING. ALSO, THREE (3) MEETINGS AND NOT INCLUDING THE PIAA FOOTBALL INTERPRETATION MEETING IS REQUIRED ELIGIBILITY PRIOR TO OFFICIAL FOOTBALL SEASON. " THIS WAS TO COMPLY WITH THE PIAA RULES. MOTION BY BOB GALLAGHER SECOND BY DON TEMPLETON THAT CHANGE IN ARTICLE 8 BE APPROVED. MOTION CARRIED.

THE FOLLOWING OFFICIALS WERE BROUGHT BEFORE THE CHAPTER TO BE REMOVED FROM THE PROBATION LIST: LARRY BUFFINGTON, DON DARR, BARRY DUNN, LARRY HAHN, RON LEWIS, WILLIAM SMITH, JIM STOLL, JOHN SULTZBAUGH, C. EDWARD THOMPSON AND WILLIAM SMITH. ON A MOTION BY REICHERT 2nd BY MULLIGAN THAT BILL SMITH AND JOHN SULTZBAUGH BE KEPT ON PROBATION FOR ONE MORE YEAR PRIMARILY BECAUSE THEY DID NOT WORK IN 1972. APPLICATIONS ON OFFICIALS VIC KARYKI AND JIM HANKS, BOTH OF WHOM TRANSFERRED FROM OTHER CHAPTERS WERE VOTED ON. MOTION BY REICHERT 2nd BY MULLIGAN THAT THEY BE ACCEPTED IN CHAPTER. MOTION PASSED. GALLAGHER & BROWN MADE ABOVE MOTION.

NEW BUSINESS: THE SUBJECT OF FEES AT UPPER DAUPHIN AND WILLIAMS VALLEY CAME UP FOR DISCUSSION. SECRETARY BENNETT MENTIONED THAT AFTER ATTENDING THE TWIN VALLEY LEAGUE MEETING BOTH THESE SCHOOLS WERE GOING TO DO THEIR BEST TO GET A RAISE IN FEES FOR 1973. (FEES HAVE BEEN INCREASED AT BOTH SCHOOLS FOR 1973)

LEONARD CZARNECKI DISTRICT #3 OFFICIALS REPRESENTATIVE TOOK THE FLOOR AND MENTIONED THE FACT THAT THE DIST #3 COMMITTEE RECOMMENDED THE USE OF 5 OFFICIALS AT ALL HIGH SCHOOLS IN THE AREA. HE ALSO STATED THAT THERE WERE NO REPORTS OF INCIDENTS IN 1972. HE SUGGESTED THAT ANYTIME WE HAVE A PROBLEM WE ARE TO LET HIM KNOW IMMEDIATELY AND THEY WILL TAKE ACTION. HE ALSO MENTIONED THAT IN 1973 ALL PLAYERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SIT ON BENCH. HE ALSO AGREED TO LOOK INTO THE SITUATION INVOLVING GAMES THAT ARE FORFEITED OR CALLED BECAUSE OF WEATHER CONDITIONS.
