

Rule 5 Questions

- 1) A's ball, 3/10 at A's 20. Quarterback runs to the A-35 where he is tackled hard. Quarterback gets up and swears at the back-judge, saying that there was illegal helmet contact on the tackle. BJ throws flag for Unsportsmanlike Conduct (dead ball foul). After assessing the 15 yard penalty back to the A20, it will be first down for A.
